

## **Lighting Tech Guidelines**

### **The Goal:**

- We will use lighting in a sensitive manner to promote an atmosphere conducive for worship.
- We will use lighting to promote effective use of video elements.
- We will use lighting so that the congregation will be able to see what is happening on stage.
- God expects our best. He deserves nothing less.

### **Be Prompt**

- On Sundays, please arrive by 8:00am and 6:15pm to look over the tech sheet and familiarize yourself with lighting changes.

### **Attend Rehearsals when necessary**

- Occasionally for special programs, your attendance at dress rehearsal (or maybe the last few rehearsals) will be necessary. Please plan accordingly.

### **Be Professional and Courteous**

- Please communicate with the other tech team members so that everyone knows what is supposed to happen

### **Be Alert and Aware**

- Be always aware of which lights should be on, how much they should be on and why.
- If there is a light out, you should be the first to recognize it.
- At some point, you will make a mistake. When that happens, recognize it and learn what to do to prevent that mistake from occurring again. No one is perfect and we work with imperfect equipment. However, we consistently strive for excellence because our Lord deserves nothing less.

### **Be Flexible**

- Tech people must be very flexible for things constantly change. Plan for change and respond appropriately.
