

Stage Tech Guidelines

The Goal:

- We will be attentive to the details regarding stage setup, microphone usage and people placement.
- We will help to make sure those backstage don't miss cues.
- God expects our best. He deserves nothing less.

Be Prompt

- On Wednesdays, be at rehearsal by 6:20pm so that you are ready for rehearsal at 6:30.
- On Sundays, please arrive by 7:45am and 6:00pm.

Attend Rehearsal

- This will allow you to be comfortable with what will happen on Sunday morning.
- Help those on stage communicate with those in the booth regarding monitor mix, etc.
- Help those in the booth communicate with those on stage regarding monitor mix, etc.
- Make notes of what items (stools, stands, etc.) are needed for each service element.

Be Professional and Courteous

- Please communicate with the worship team, speakers and other tech team members so that everyone knows what is supposed to happen. Don't be afraid to remind someone twice.

Be Alert, Aware and Flexible

- Please pay attention to what's happening on stage and respond accordingly. Things do not always happen as planned. Expect changes to happen and respond appropriately.
- The goal of this position is for you to have your finger on the pulse of what's happening on stage. You should know what's happening next before it happens. The goal of the tech team is for the service to be as smooth as possible so that God's glory would be revealed to those present and that the atmosphere would be conducive to worship.
